- ❑ 2012: School CPTED Training
- ❑ 2012-2014: Initial CPTED intervention in **14** communities
- ❑ 2014-2015: CPTED University Diplomat
- ❑ 2015: CPTED intervention in **10** communities

EXECUTION OF CPTED PROJECTS

Objectives of PEC Methodology
PEC Model (Projects Executed by the Community)

- Generate social capital
- Promote local empowerment, commitment, ownership, sustainability and social cohesion
- Development of local capabilities
- Increase access to social infrastructure to reduce opportunities of crime to occur and increase the perception of security at the community level
- Increase scope of work – labor provided by the community
- Secure the adequate, fair and transparent use of financial resources.
